Asked by Nicole Lawder MLA:

In relation to: City to the Lake – Parkes Way overpass

1. Considering the decision to rethink the dropping of Parkes Way; how is the government now considering connecting West Basin to the city?
2. When is this connection expected to begin?

ANDREW BARR: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. The National Capital Plan prescribes certain requirements for the development of West Basin, this includes extending the city grid of streets and paths from the city to West Basin, and the creation of a land bridge over Parkes Way. The intent of this work is to deliver the dramatically improved connectivity between the city and the West Basin. This work does not require the lowering of Parkes Way.
2. Connectivity improvements described above are likely to be linked to land release in West Basin.
