As you may be aware, on Thursday, 12 April 2018 the Legislative Assembly established a Select Committee on Privileges to investigate the actions of certain Members in relation to an inquiry of the Standing Committee on Public Accounts relating to the methodology for determining rates and land tax for apartments.


- how the website was administered;
