Do you have a breakdown of the levels you are recruiting in? Is it executive teachers? Is it entry-level teachers?

Ms Yvette Berry, MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

In 2019, the Education Directorate undertook a centralised recruitment process to fill approximately 200 classroom teacher vacancies for the upcoming 2020 school year. This recruitment initiative was at the classroom teacher classification level and was open to the full array of teaching experience, school sectors and specialties eg primary school teachers, language teachers and disability educators.
