Asked by Mr Cain MLA:

In relation to:

**What is the timeframe for determining enrolment disputes?**

Minister Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The Education Directorate conducts preschool reviews, usually within 10 days of receiving the preschool review request.

Schools conduct K-12 enrolment reviews. The Education Directorate recommends schools conduct K-12 enrolment reviews within 10 days of receiving the review request.

If a family is not satisfied with the review of the original enrolment decision, they can also make an enrolment appeal through the Education Directorate. Appeals are usually conducted within a 6-week period and every effort is taken to conduct and conclude an appeal as swiftly as possible, often within less than 6 weeks.
