In relation to: Gendered Urban Design

1. What consultation work has been completed with young women aged 15-21 on urban design such as upgrades to local shopping centres?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. TCCS undertook community consultation on the upgrades to Duffy, Campbell and Kaleen Shops. This included comments from that age bracket as part of the wider consultation.

The Gender Sensitive Urban Design Guidelines project being sponsored by TCCS is undertaking targeted consultation work with young women aged 15-21 on urban design issues as part of the larger consultation component of the project.

Consultation for Gender Sensitive Urban Design Guidelines was postponed during the COVID 19 lockdown. It is expected to recommence in the coming months.
