Asked by Elizabeth Kikkert: To ask the Minister for Families and Community Services

Ref: Child and Youth Protection Services, Budget Statement G, p. 24, output class CSD 2.3 Child and Youth Protection Services

In relation to: More Support for Out of Home Care

- 1. What was the \$625,000 for 'More support for the Out of Home Care system' in the last financial year intended for?
- 2. Why was this money unspent last year?

RACHEL STEPHEN-SMITH MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. The \$625,000 for 'More Support for the Out of Home Care system' had a two-fold purpose. This funding was used as part of the establishment and ongoing costs for a therapeutic residential care program. The second component was for the operational costs for the redesign and post strategy evaluation of the *A Step Up for Our Kids* out of home care strategy.
- 2. The underspend in the therapeutic residential care program can be attributed to a delay in the establishment of this service and the program not being occupied at the rate anticipated, hence resulting in an underspend. The post strategy evaluation also incurred a delay in establishment.
