In relation to: Controlled Activity orders

- 1. How many prohibition notices and controlled activity orders were issued in 2019, 2020 and 2021?
- 2. How many FTEs are issuing these?
- 3. How many FTE inspectors does Access Canberra have to deal with planning issues?
- 4. How does this compare to other councils?

MINISTER STEEL: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

<b>Controlled Activity Orders</b>	7	7	6

- 2. 21 officers (inspectors and investigators) in the Access Canberra Construction and Regulation Section regulate both planning and building matters as part of their functions.
- 3. Please see answer to question 2 above.
- 4. As identified in response to previous questions, the allocation of staff to multiple legislative functions does not support a meaningful resource comparison with other organisations and would be an unreasonable diversion of resources to try and determine.
