- Clause 8, page 20, line 21, proposed new section 17W (3), omit "(3)" and substitute "(4)"
- Clause 8, page 21, line 4, proposed new section 17W (4), omit "(4)" and substitute "(5)"
- Clause 64, page 116, line 23, as amended by Government Assembly amendment 42, omit "polices" and substitute "policies"
- Clause 64, page 116, line 23, as amended by Government Assembly amendment 42, omit "—" and substitute "·"
- Clause 8, page 27, line 15, proposed new section 17ZH (3) (a) (ii), as amended by Government Assembly amendment 29, after "·" insert "and"
- Consequential renumbering as a result of the Assembly amendments to clause 33.
