In relation to:

- (1) Does the ACT Government intend to introduce a fee for patrons of the Flexible Bus Service in the future?

CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

- (1) The flexible bus service is offered free of charge to a defined group of registered users including people aged 70 or older, Disability Pension Card holders with a mobility difficulty, people impacted by a permanent or temporary disability that prevents them from accessing regular route services and holders of a Vision Impaired (VIP), or Total and Permanently Incapacitated (TPI) travel pass. There are no plans to introduce a fee for this service at this time.
