A total of 15 proposals have been submitted through Housing ACT's Expression of Interest Mechanism.

Two proposals have been received in the past 12 months.

Approximately \$7,500 has been spent in marketing/advertising for Housing ACT's Expression of Interest Mechanism. This has involved advertising in local press media, online/social media, and industry specific publications.
