- (1) Can you please provide a comparison in rights to review planning decisions in the *Planning and Development Act 2007* and the Planning Bill 2022?
- (2) Can you please identify the limits on the ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal power to review a decision in the bill, and identify the sections in the bill?

Mick Gentleman MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

- 1) The only difference is that third party appeals have been removed for subdivision design applications (previously known as estate development plans).
- 2) Powers of the tribunal are outlined in the *ACT Civil and Administrative Tribunal Act 2008*.
