## Inquiry into Work Health and Safety Amendment Bill 2022 - report tabled

The Standing Committee on Public Accounts today tabled the Committee's report on its *Inquiry into Work Health and Safety Amendment Bill 2022*.

The Chair, Mrs Elizabeth Kikkert MLA, said: 'It was important for our Committee to conduct this inquiry to review the legislative change proposed by this Bill, which was introduced after a matter of parliamentary privilege was bought to light during the budget inquiry of the Legislative Assembly's Select Committee on Estimates 2022-2023'.

'The report examined the balance between parliamentary privilege and statutory law which informed the necessity of the Bill, and made a total of 4 recommendations'.

'The Committee wishes to thank the Ministers, the WorkSafe ACT Commissioner, the Speaker and the Office of the Legislative Assembly for their participation in this inquiry'.
