ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by Ms Jo Clay MLA on 18 July 2023: Mr Cahif took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

MS CLAY: Okay. No, that is good. And can you break down just briefly what—we have got \$196.8 million across four years for light rail stage 2. What are the components of that?

Mr Steel: I might ask Ash Cahif, if he is available, to provide some further information.

Mr Cahif: Ashley Cahif, I am the project director for light rail stage 2, from Major Projects Canberra. I will need to take that on notice as to the specific figures, but what is contained as broad projects—so raising London Circuit is a separate project, but 2A includes not only the design work for 2A leading up to the works approval, the procurement with Canberra Metro, the LRV and depot mod, and then we have 2B as well has separate funding.

MS CLAY: That would be great, and the detail on notice would be great, thank you.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The breakdown of the 2023-24 Budget item *Better Transport Infrastructure – Light Rail Stage 2A and 2B* is as follows:
