MS JO CLAY MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Portfolio area, City Services – Roads ACT

Hearing Date: 18 July 2023

In relation to: Path Sweeping in TCCS

City Renewal Authority have recently purchased a fully electric path sweeper for cleaning paths in CRA managed areas.

1. Does TCCS have any path sweepers which can be used for footpaths, shared paths or bike lanes?
2. Does TCCS have any plans to purchase any in order to better clean paths and bike lanes?
3. If not why not?

CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1. Yes, Place Management has four path sweeper broom attachments that are used to clean shared paths. There are also three towed debris blowers that can be used for this purpose. Roads ACT operates five mechanical sweeper trucks that sweep roads and the adjoining cycle lanes where these are present.
2. TCCS is currently in the process of purchasing four additional debris blowers that may be able to assist in shared path cleaning.
