ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

MS JO CLAY MLA: To ask the Minister for Transport and City Services

Ref: Portfolio area, Infrastructure Delivery / Roads - City Services

Hearing Date: 18 July 2023

In relation to: TCCS Road Projects Costs

What is the anticipated final cost of the following projects including any costs for the design and planning as well as construction?

- A. William Hovell Drive Duplication
- B. Gundaroo Drive Duplication Stage 1, 2, and 3,
- C. Molonglo River Bridge
- D. Monaro Highway Upgrade (Current and planned stages)
- E. Athllon Drive Duplication

CHRIS STEEL MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

A. The current anticipated cost of William Hovell Drive Duplication is \$109.55 million inclusive of feasibility study, detailed design, planning approvals and construction.

B. The total cost of various stages of Gundaroo Drive duplication is as follows:

- Gundaroo Drive Stage 1 – actual costs of \$31.221m.
- Gundaroo Drive Stage 2 – actual cost of \$28.242m.
- Gundaroo Drive intersection with Anthony Rolfe Avenue/Mirrabei Drive - \$2.8m.
- Gundaroo Drive Stage 3 – anticipated total cost of \$60.173m.

C. The current anticipated cost of the Molonglo River Bridge is \$203.141m including costs of concept design, early planning, detailed design and construction.

D. The anticipated cost of Monaro Highway is \$182.1m (budgeted) with an additional \$48.4m in provisions amounting to a project total of \$230.5m.

E. TCCS do not currently have an anticipated construction cost for Athllon Drive as the project team are still undertaking detailed design of the southern section and are yet to commence detailed design of the northern section. The current budget is \$5.92m including concept design and detailed design elements.
