In relation to: Safer families - Community-led family violence responses for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities

- (1) Can the Minister please detail each of the family violence responses for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities that will be implemented?
 - (a) What is the expected date of implementation for each of these responses?

MINISTER BERRY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

1. Following consultation with the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people, and advice from the Domestic Violence Prevention Council's Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Reference Group, a dedicated Women's Service will be established to deliver Recommendation 4 of the We Don't Shoot Our Wounded Report.
 - a) Yerrabi Yurwang are implementing their Nara-Gana-Wali Strengthening Families Program during the 2023-24 financial year. The government has granted \$530,000 through an open process to Yerrabi Yurwang to deliver this work.
