Rebecca Minty, Inspector of Correctional Services: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

There are no budget decisions changed as a direct result of applying the wellbeing impact assessment or gender analysis tool. We do not deliver programs or services and are not involved in preparing submissions for Cabinet. Under the *Inspector of Correctional Services Act 2017* our role is to conduct mandated reviews of correctional centres and correctional services.

We utilise the 'Healthy Prison Test' to inform the Standards that underpin our review and monitoring work, these were originally developed by the World Health Organisation. They are specifically tailored to a carceral environment and aspects of the 12 Wellbeing Domains are reflected in these Standards.

There are no budget decisions changed as a result of applying the gender analysis tool. The Standards do include standards relating to gender and non-discrimination, to guide a gender responsive approach to monitoring custody.
