In relation to: Callam Offices Building Upgrades

MS CLAY: Thank you, Chair. Minister, in 2021-22 the budget put over \$15 million to install new heating, new ventilation and a new cooling system in Callam Offices and building upgrades to improve energy efficiency and effectively maintain that heritage listed asset. Can you tell me how much of that money was spent and what the outcomes have been so far, and then perhaps why ACT government has now decided not to use that building any longer?

Mr Steel: Yes, so we can certainly provide the exact amount on notice, noting that I do not think we have representatives from Property Group here for obvious reasons this week.

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

I am advised that \$52,002 has been spent from the funding allocated in the 2021-22 Budget.
