MS LAWDER: Just out of curiosity I notice in the list of grants on page 167 there was over \$18,000 to the Trustee for Farrow Family Trust for installation of an automatic front entry door. But who is the Farrow's Family Trust is that you mentioned about organisations and clubs, et cetera. Who is it that this particular group is and who are they providing access for?

Ms Davidson: I think we might take that on notice.

MS LAWDER: You know, nearly 20 per cent of the entire club for the year.

Ms Davidson: We will take that on notice.

Ms Emma Davidson MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The Trustee for Faraz Family Trust provides a General Practice service at the Waramanga Medical Centre. This organisation received a grant of \$18,229 under the 2022-23 Disability Inclusion Grants to fund the installation of an automatic front entry door at the medical centre. Funding was awarded following a merit-based process in accordance with the grant guidelines.
