**MS LAWDER:** On the Age-Friendly City Program, which would be the next suburbs to be addressed?

**Ms Davidson:** I do believe I did talk about that earlier in the year when I was tabling the third annual report. That was back in May, and we are in late November now, so I cannot remember off the top of my head the list of suburbs and I am probably going to get it wrong. I will take that on notice to get back to you.

Ms Emma Davidson MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The Age Friendly Suburbs Program (the Program) forms part of the Aged-Friendly City Plan. The Program involves improvements to the path network to provide better access for all Canberrans.

In the second half of 2022, the ACT Government invited feedback from stakeholders and the broader community on proposed age friendly improvements in the suburbs of Chifley, O'Connor, Scullin and Reid. Further detail on the locations identified for delivery can be found [here](#).
