### Report tabled – Inquiry into Cashless gaming in the ACT

Today the Chair of Standing Committee on Justice and Community Safety, Mr Peter Cain MLA, tabled the Committee's report for its *Inquiry into Cashless gaming in the ACT*.

The Committee has made five recommendations, including that the ACT Government articulate a long-term vision for gambling harm reduction in the ACT. A dissenting report was made by Mr Peter Cain MLA, while additional comments were made by Mr Andrew Braddock MLA.
