  - (i) the SES member's administrative unit; and
  - (ii) for the head of service—the service; and
- (c) implements the principles of the National Agreement on Closing the Gap; and
- (d) promotes cultural safety (within the meaning of the National Agreement on Closing the Gap) for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples; and
- (e) works to eliminate institutional racism.

# 253 Review of amendments made by Public Sector (Closing the Gap) Legislation Amendment Act 2025

- (1) The Minister must review the operation of the amendments to this Act made by the *Public Sector (Closing the Gap) Legislation Amendment Act 2025* as soon as practicable after 1 July 2027.
- (2) The Minister must present a report of the review to the Legislative Assembly within 6 months after the review is started.
- (3) This section expires on 31 December 2029.
