Has any consideration been given to a direct bus service between the rapidly growing Molonglo Valley and the Parkes/Barton area, similar to the 59 route which runs direct from Woden? If not, why not?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

No. As previously stated, the Government is exploring opportunities integrate bus services from Weston Creek and Molonglo (continuing through to the City) with Light Rail Stage 2B which will service Parkes and Barton. New light rail stop infrastructure would make connections possible at stops like Woden Interchange, Kent Street and Albert Hall, with connecting passengers then getting off/on at stops on State Circle.
