(incident form attached) at this time i called mum to inform of incident and child was displaying no symptoms and appeared well. Mum was OK with this and we both agreed at that stage to monitor child for any change.</p> <p>I began to look on ACT health in regards to Death Cap mushroom and then called Poisons information for further clarification.</p> <p>Poisons information advised that given that the mushroom was possibly ingested and we are located in Canberra that the child attend the emergency department with a sample of the mushroom for further investigation.</p> <p>I contacted mum at 12:30 approx and she agreed that this would be a good action to take just to be save.</p> <p>Child was collected form the service at 1:15pm Photos of where the mushroom was found and sample of mushroom supplied to family when child was collected.</p>
