FOOSHC received an email 1.10.2020 from the parents of **P01** **P01** aged 8 year old who currently attends FOOSHC - School Holiday Program and After School Care at FOOSHC since Term 1 2020, after returning to Australia from and overseas posting. This email contained a concern that **P01** had an unusual number of bruises on his lower limbs possibly from attending holiday care on Tuesday 29.9.2020 and on Wednesday 30.09.2020. The parents were concerned by these bruises and visited the hospital that evening in case he could have some form of blood illness.

The doctors that examined and spoke to **P01** where he advised that the bruises were from a child at School Holiday program (SHP) who he had a disagreement with. The child only attended one day of SHP.

On Tuesday 29/09/20, **P01** had an altercation with another child over the use of an air hockey table. The interaction was physical and brief consisting of a punch being thrown by both children and a shove to the upper body of **P01**. No kicking was observed by the Educator supervising.

In another incident on Wednesday 30/09/20, **P01** became upset over a social interaction with a close friend and began throwing and kicking chairs in the junior hall. An educator calmed him, and no obvious injuries were noted.

Additionally, on Wednesday 2/10/20, **P01** was playing on the inflatable's incursion. This consisted of jumping on an inflatable obstacle course with other children in close proximity. **P01** played on this obstacle for most of the booked time (10 AM to 12 PM).

On receiving the parents email, the Responsible Person (**P01** **P01**) spoke to the mother (**P01** **P01**) about her concerns and she expressed that **P01** was not feeling safe. She requested that we check in with **P01** to reassure him that he can speak to the Educators about any concerns and that the team would be notified of these concerns. Mother was reassured we would talk to **P01** and notify them if we notice any further bruising or possible injuries which might have caused this. After the discussion with mother, this was further reinforced in an email to **P01**'s parents. The mother appeared happy with our actions and response.

The team and director team met to discuss **P01**'s incident and as **P01** had assisted with the restorative conversation on Tuesday 29.9.20, **P01** did not believe the bruises came from that one altercation. We have continued to monitor **P01** very closely and have not noticed any further incidents which may lead to further bruising.

In a conversation with Mother (**P01**) on Thursday afternoon 1/10/20, **P01** **P01** and **P01** **P01** expressed their concern about the number of bruises and how 1 one incident couldn't have caused such the amount of bruising. **P01** asked if **P01** had discussed any other injuries or altercations with other children at School Holiday program. We all agree to monitor and speak the next day. Mother sent another email on 1.10.2020 she was happy with the care **P01** has received at Fooshc.
