Chris Steel MLA took on notice the following question(s):

Mr Green: Ben Green, Executive Group Manager, Policy, Planning and Built Environment. The other thing I would probably just add to that, whilst the travel survey is out, we are also conscious that the ABS census, 26th census, will provide us with a good sense of information, particularly around demographic and that journey to work data. So that will be incorporated into the modelling that updates our Canberra Strategic Transport Model. That is done on a five-yearly cycle. So that information will come through, we will be able to provide some further advice.

MR EMERSON: So just very, very quickly, chair, but is there a question on the new survey that says, “Do you work from home”, so that they can be kind of carved off from the remainder of the percentages?

Mr Green: I will get some advice, potentially—

Mr Steel: We will take that on notice. We can provide the full survey form if you want.

MR EMERSON: Yes. Thanks. That would be great, yes. Thank you.

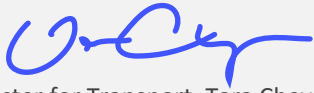
Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:
