**NUMBER OF CHILDREN AND FUNDING FOR SCAN STUDENTS IN
NON-GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS**

MR DOSZPOT - asked the Minister for Education and Training on 17 February 2009:

- (1) Can you provide the number of students who are identified by the SCAN process in non-government schools and the amount of funding that is provided to those schools in total?

MR BARR - the answer to Mr Doszpot's question is:

- (1) There were 363 non-government students with disabilities at the February 2007 ACT census. ACT Government grants of \$0.909m (GST exclusive) were provided at an average of \$2,504 per student. The ACT Government also provided \$0.7m (GST exclusive) in disability access grants to non-government schools in 2007-08.
