Is the Government considering selling the assets of Capital Linen?

**SHANE RATTENBURY MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The Government announced in 2014-15 Budget it will be considering, over the coming months, which assets could be included under the Commonwealth Government's Asset Recycling Initiative.

Capital Linen Service occupies a leased building and its plant and equipment assets are substantially depreciated and the Fleet leased. It is therefore not suitable for sale and leaseback arrangement.
