ANDREW BARR: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

Q1 - Q7.

The 2016-17 ACT Budget identified \$400,000 for a feasibility study into a new Civic Pool. Since the funding was identified, the Australian National University (ANU) commenced planning for a new public pool on the ANU campus. The progress of the feasibility study was deferred pending the outcome of planning for the new ANU Pool. The funding was rolled over into the 2017-18 budget.
