Asked by ALISTAIR COE MLA:

In relation to: CNG loan fund update

Mr Sutton: Sorry, I think it is worth mentioning that the largest loan fund year have been four or five applications, has been the largest year we have had to date. So we will be trying to exceed that.

MR COE: Is it mentioned in the annual report somewhere or not? This program?

Mr Rattenbury: The CNG loan part?

MR COE: Yes.

Mr Rutledge: I do not think it is in the annual report. But we will provide the committee with a program update. So I will take that on notice.

MR COE: So, were there—you mentioned that 17-18 was a slower year for the fund, so were there any projects in 17-18, or was there one that you mentioned 16-17?—

Mr Rutledge: Well that was finalised in 17-18 but actually it started the previous year. But why do we not just give the committee an update for the previous three years.

MINISTER RATTENBURY: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—
