Ms Caroline Le Couteur: To ask the Minister for Roads & Active Travel

Ref: TCCS – City Services pp 260, 261, 29

In relation to: Path maintenance and asset management

1. What is the estimated staffing and cost required to conduct a Condition Assessment for the whole path network?
2. Could this be funded internally, or would supplemental funding be needed?

Mr Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

1. An estimated 12,230 staff hours and vehicle costs, hence, accounting for relevant costs, estimated total cost is approximately \$855,000 per year.
2. The path inspection program is currently resourced from the TCCS recurrent budget on a risk management basis to maximise the outcomes achieved from the path maintenance program. To expand this supplementary funding would be required.
