Asked by Mark Parton MLA:

In relation to: Class A, B and C Builder Licence refusals in 2018-19.

MR PARTON: All right. Specifically, when it comes to the building licences, can I ask, and I understand that you may not have this information on you, but in 2018-19, how many applications were there for each of the A, B and C class building licenses? Perhaps—

Mr Green: I can answer that question for you.

MR PARTON: Yes.

Mr Green: So for the period 2018-19, for builders licenses and by class, did you want it split by individual and corporation and partnership as well?

MR PARTON: No, not necessarily.

Mr Green: Okay. For class A builder licenses, there were 102 licenses issued. For class B, there were 56. For class C, there was 120. For class D, there was 22. And there were 250 owner builder licenses issued.

MR PARTON: So that is the number of licenses that were issued.

Mr Green: Yes.

MR PARTON: I just wonder if you have got information on how many applications were unsuccessful?

Mr Green: I do not have that information in front of me, but we can certainly get that information for you.

Gordon Ramsay MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:—

13 builder licence applications were refused in the 2018-19 financial year.



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A breakdown of the builder licence refusals by licence class is as follows:

- Class A Builder – 1 application refused
- Class C Builder – 11 applications refused
- Class D Builder – 1 application refused
