Asked by ALISTAIR COE MLA:

In relation to: Notifiable invoices from Oracle system

What proportion of notifiable invoices in the register come from the Oracle system?

SUZANNE ORR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

In order to develop the list for publication of notifiable invoices, data is collected from a number of systems used across government. The majority of those invoices that meet the threshold for notification come from the Oracle System, but all other data sources have to be checked to pick up those that are not in Oracle. A review of a sample from recent months (April 2019 to August 2019) showed that more than 90 per cent of notifiable invoices were generated from Oracle.
