In relation to: Boomanulla Oval

The Boomanulla Raiders football team received a CSIG grant. Can the minister please clarify the annual cost of maintaining Boomanulla Oval and also provide data on how often the oval is used?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The annual cost of maintaining Boomanulla Oval is incorporated into the overall budget for sportsground maintenance across the city, figures are not captured for individual ovals due to the way that servicing is delivered across all sportsgrounds assets. The oval is used for winter sports by the Boomanulla Raiders and the Narrabundah Football Club. The meeting room is also regularly booked out for meetings by indigenous groups. In the last 12 months there have been 84 bookings.
