In relation to: Bus Advertising

Bus advertising brings in \$1,267,000 in revenue. What is the cost to administer the program?

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

The bus advertising contract is administered along with a range of contracts under the Senior Director Procurement and Assets. Management of the contract is included as a business as usual task and would be considered as approximately 5-10% of the officers' general responsibilities. The vendor works within set parameters set out in the contract and only requires more intensive direct interface with the Senior Director during contract review period.
