Asked by Mr Jeremy Hanson MLA: To ask the Minister for Police and Emergency Services:

In relation to: **Callouts**

Ref EBT 1 - ACT Policing

- a. What is the number of callouts in each year from the Woden Police Station in different categories of callout in each of the last five years that have dealt with an issue in:
1. Woden
  2. Weston Creek
  3. Molonglo
  4. Elsewhere.

Mick Gentleman MLA: I am advise the answer to the Member's question are as follows:–

ACT Policing patrols can respond and attend to incidents anywhere within the ACT, regardless of which of the five police stations they are formally assigned to (Woden, Tuggeranong, Gungahlin, Belconnen and City). ACT Policing members from Road Policing assigned to the Traffic Operations Centre also respond to incidents where required across the ACT. This model ensures that incidents are responded to efficiently and effectively, with the entirety of ACT Policing's resources directed to the most pressing priorities across the region. The figures below are attendances by police attached to Woden Police Station only and are not the total number of callouts by ACT Policing members to those areas.
