ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Asked by Peter Cain MLA on 18 October 2021:

In relation to: (uncorrected proof transcript)

MR CAIN: Look, and this might be on notice, Commissioner. But since the establishment operationally in December 2019, close to two years ago, could you outline how many complaints you have received, then investigated, then concluded and public reported on?

The Hon Michael Adams QC: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:–

The ACT Integrity Commission has received 242 complaints since December 1, 2019.
169 complaints have been concluded with the following action:

- 151 dismissed
- 18 referred to other entities.

The Commission currently has 37 matters within the assessment process with reports being prepared and or awaiting panel decision.

The Commission is currently investigating 10 complaints and undertaking 26 preliminary inquiries.

No investigations have been publicly reported on.
