ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE
1 March 2022

Asked by Ms Lawder on 1 March 2022: Minister Rattenbury took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

MS LAWDER: I think I have asked this before, but I have yet to receive it. Could you provide a copy of the music software model for the assets and the water quality data collected on the healthy waterway assets to the committee?

Mr Walker: That information can be provided, Ms Lawder.

MS LAWDER: Thanks. I am also interested in—and, again, my recollection is that we have discussed these in the past—the Healthy Waterways design acceptance reports and the operations and maintenance manuals that would have got passed over when the department or the directorate accepted those infrastructure pieces. And also I had a question on notice, 477, about Lake Tuggeranong water quality monitoring data. I received six months' worth of data. The question was actually about data from 2010 to 2020, and also now post-July 2021, excluding the algae and coliform data from 2015 to 2020. I can provide that in writing, if that helps you.

Mr Rattenbury: That might be the best approach, Ms Lawder. As I have signed them all off, I know we have provided you with large amounts of data, but I am happy to have a look at that detail and see if there is further information we can provide you.

Minister Rattenbury: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-


The water quality data requested are in the process of being provided to Ms Lawder MLA via the response to Question on Notice (QON) 582.

The Model for Urban Stormwater Improvement Conceptualisation (MUSIC) models will be provided in response to QON 583. Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development Directorate staff are currently removing information of a personal nature.

The design acceptance reports and operation and maintenance (O&M) manuals for the Healthy Waterways water quality assets are owned and held by Transport Canberra City Services (TCCS). A request for these manuals would be best placed with TCCS.
