Asked by Mr Cain on 4 March 2022: Minister Berry took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

MR CAIN: And have any staff—so obviously the checks that you have got in place are sensible ones, have you had instances where staff have not made the appropriate declarations and been able to purchase land, or a close relative?

Mr Dietz: We have not had—to my awareness, we have not had any staff who have not declared an interest and have resulted in the purchase of land. We have had staff who, through the process, we have been identified and worked with them to realise that a registration process may have begun, and we have needed to work with them to ensure that they were not part of the proceeding of that registration process.

Minister Berry: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

I am not aware of any instances where staff or immediate family of staff members have not made the appropriate declarations and proceeded to purchase land from the Suburban Land Agency.
