- 1. What engagement has the ACT Government had with the NSW Government regarding the proposed Veolia Waste Incinerator at Tarago?
- 2. Given the potential long-term potential pollution this project could have on Canberra and its surrounds, what's your government's position in relation to this matter?

ANDREW BARR MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- 1. The ACT Government has had no engagement with the NSW Government regarding the proposed Veolia Waste Incinerator in Tarago.
- 2. The ACT Government will continue to monitor the progress of the proposed facility and should the potential for impacts on the ACT become apparent, at that point the ACT Government would consider whether engagement with NSW is required.
