ANSWER TO QUESTION ON NOTICE

Elizabeth Lee MLA: To ask the Minister for Skills:

1. With reference to former CIT employee Ms. Cathy Hudson, please advise:
 - a) What the full terms of employment for Ms. Hudson were, including but not limited to:
 - i) The level at which Ms. Hudson was employed
 - ii) The salary of Ms. Hudson
 - iii) A description of Ms. Hudson's duties
 - b) If the role for Ms. Hudson was advertised and, if so, when and through what channels?
Please provide a copy of the advertisement and any relevant documentation.
 - c) If the role that Ms. Hudson was employed in was a permanent position?
 - d) What were the dates at which Ms. Hudson commenced and ended her employment at CIT,
and what was the reason for her departure?

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: –

CIT, an independent body with a governing board, advises that Ms Hudson was engaged as a casual then temporary employee of CIT from 2016 to 13 July 2021 in Position 37350 as a part time Senior Officer Grade A.

The position description for the role from 2016 is [Attachment A](#). The terms and conditions, including salary of this position are per the applicable Enterprise Agreement at the time. Conditions are applied on a pro-rata basis for part-time employees. The position was initially filled through the CIT temporary employment register and Gazetted on 11 September 2018
