## ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by Andrew Braddock MLA on 26 August 2022: Chris Steel MLA took on notice the following question:

In relation to: Geographical spread of sites for community facilities.

MR BRADDOCK: I am just worried about the geographical spread of the facilities across the territory and particularly where new-built areas like Gungahlin or Molonglo might be, let us say, deficient in space. Is it possible to get some figures as to what the spread of your available spaces area and be able to see if that is the case?

Mr Tanton: Absolutely. I am happy to take that on notice and come back to you on that one. As I said, there is quite a broad range of facilities, especially in some of the more mature suburbs in Tuggeranong, North, Belconnen and Inner South. But I am happy to provide you with that on notice, absolutely.

Chris Steel MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows: -
