In relation to: 2022-23 Budget Review: Bimberi Youth Justice Centre (Bimberi)

- 1. Can the treasurer please explain and quantify the 'increased operational demand at the Bimberi Youth Justice Centre' for which an additional \$1.583 million in funding has been allocated?
- 2. Can the treasurer please provide a breakdown by year of what this funding will pay for?

Mr Andrew Barr MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:-

- The additional funds each year are operational funding for Bimberi Youth Justice Centre's fourth
  residential unit, which will require resourcing of six additional FTE Youth Worker Level 1/2
  positions, and associated operating costs. The fourth residential unit is required to accommodate
  a temporary increase in the average daily numbers of young people in detention.
