ANSWER TO QUESTION TAKEN ON NOTICE DURING PUBLIC HEARINGS

Asked by Mr Andrew Braddock MLA on 18 July 2023: Mr Chris Steel MLA took on notice the following question(s):

In relation to:

Can you confirm if you will publish the Gungahlin transport feasibility study?

Ms Clement: So, as the minister said, we have completed a feasibility study that looked at how the active travel is operating in the Gungahlin town centre area at the moment and where we think we need improvements and what those improvements might look like. It did develop a number of links. There are 11 links, they have some subpackages within those. So this project will take those concept options and develop the high priority ones up to detailed design, and some of those—so our first stage will be a planning stage to test and check the ones that we do take to detailed design but it will likely be—a couple of examples are along Gundaroo Drive in the southern verge between Mirrabai Drive and Horse Park Drive. There is the connection from Gribble Street to Yerrabi Pond via Wunderlich Street, so it is that type of work where we are looking at either there is a missing link or we are augmenting and improving the connection or link that is there at the moment.

MR PETTERSSON: What sort of timeline are we looking at to see some of those—

Ms Clement: See some of that design work? So I would expect you to be able to see some of that design work only next year.

MR PETTERSSON: That is very exciting. Thank you.

THE CHAIR: Thank you, Mr Pettersson. Supplementary or a substantive?

MR BRADDOCK: Supplementary.

THE CHAIR: Supplementary. Yes.

MR BRADDOCK: A quick one I promise, Chair.

THE CHAIR: No, you are all good.

MR BRADDOCK: Is it possible that the feasibility study be published?

Mr Steel: I will take that on notice.
