Inquiry into the Territory Plan and other associated documents – report tabled

On Friday 8 March 2024, the Chair of the Standing Committee on Planning, Transport and City Services, Ms Jo Clay MLA, tabled the report on the Inquiry into the Territory Plan and associated documents.

The report makes 30 recommendations across a wide range of matters covered by the Territory Plan.
