## ACCOMPANYING STATEMENT

---

### Background

Section 10 of the *Remuneration Tribunal Act 1995* (the Act) provides for the Remuneration Tribunal (the Tribunal) to inquire into and determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements to be paid to a person holding a position or appointment mentioned in schedule 1 of the Act, or specified in an instrument given to the Tribunal by the Chief Minister.

On 04 April 2024, the Chief Minister requested the Tribunal to determine the remuneration, allowances and other entitlements for the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Board of Engineering Excellence.

### Considerations

The Tribunal noted that the Board of Engineering Excellence is a non-statutory body established to provide advice on emerging engineering issues, workforce planning and industry related matters and leadership to the ACT Government. The Board of Engineering Excellence will advocate for the engineering sector, promote innovation and support the implementation of the ACT Professional Engineer Registration Scheme. The Chair, Deputy Chair and Members will be part-time public office holders.

In considering the remuneration of the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Board of Engineering Excellence, the Tribunal had regard to the proposed work value of the Chair, Deputy Chair and Members of the Board of Engineering Excellence as well as remuneration of similar positions in the ACT.

### Decision

The Tribunal determined remuneration of \$615 per diem for the Chair of the Board of Engineering Excellence, \$570 per diem for the Deputy Chair of the Board of Engineering Excellence and \$525 per diem for Members of the Board of Engineering Excellence.
