More than \$4m from "Better transport infrastructure – Supporting active travel" was reprofiled from this year and last year into forward years.

- 1) Which of the projects within that category have been delayed? The 24-25 Budget still indicates completion in June 2026, is this still the case?

Minister Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- 1) Sulwood Drive improvements have experienced some delays during the design phase due to coordination between government agencies related to the provision of new tree plantings and responding to community feedback from the consultation stages.

The projects included in this package are all estimated to be completed by June 2026, weather and site conditions permitting. The reprofiling represents a change to the expenditure profile, not to the completion dates.
