- (1) Please provide details of who is responsible for organising and paying for the organisations as part KAP to move into the new location?
- (2) Do all of the organisations intended to be part of KAP receive indexation annually as part of their funding agreements?

**Tara Cheyne MLA:** The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) artsACT, through the budget provided for managing the Kingston Arts Precinct, will provide support to the arts organisations to move to the Precinct.
- (2) Yes, the current Deed of Grants for the six arts organisations that will be part of the Kingston Arts Precinct allows for indexation, as determined by the Territory, to be paid from 2024.  
Indexation of 2.5 per cent was applied to recurrent funding delivered through the ACT Arts Fund in 2024-25; this indexation was fully passed to funded arts organisations in their 31 July 2024 instalment.
