- (1) Can you please provide a breakdown on the use of the \$870 million budgeted for the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program between 2019-20 and 2026-27?
- (2) How will the \$477.6 million that was reinvested into the Program from the sale of 610 end-of-use public housing properties in 2023-24 be used?
- (3) Which suburbs were the 610 end-of-use properties that were sold as part of the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program in 2023-24 located?
- (4) Which suburbs have tenants that have been relocated under the Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program in 2023-24 moved from and moved to?

Yvette Berry MLA: The answer to the Member's question is as follows:

- (1) As at 31 December 2024, the \$870 million budgeted for the *Growing and Renewing Public Housing Program* (G&R Program) has funded program costs associated with the:
 - purchase of 120 land sites;
 - purchase of 208 dwellings;
 - delivery of 764 dwellings via construction; and
 - progress for the remaining 428 dwellings to be delivered as part of the G&R Program.

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- (2) Revenue generated from the sale of end-of-use public housing properties is reinvested back into the G&R Program to support the acquisition of land, the purchase of dwellings, and the construction of new homes.
- (3) The 610 sales under the program have occurred in the following suburbs:
