1. In March 2025, the ACT Government committed to installing a pedestrian crossing near the intersection of New South Wales Crescent and Telopea Park. This project is listed as “under construction” on the ACT Government’s walking and cycling infrastructure map and is under the ‘design’ header on the School Safety Program List.
2. Is the project in the design phase or the construction phase?
3. When will construction of this crossing be complete?

Ms Tara Cheyne MLA: The answer to the Member’s question is as follows:

1. The project is funded for design and construction. On the ACT Government’s walking and cycling infrastructure map describes projects that are funded for design and construction as “under construction”. The design work is anticipated to be complete in December 2025.
2. Construction procurement will commence in December 2025, with construction planned to be undertaken during the April 2026 school holiday period and be fully complete in May 2026.
